Action Points

- The Indian government denies that the caste system still exists in India, although everyone knows that it does. It is part and parcel of Hinduism. Make yourself aware of the all-encompassing plight of the Dalits and be willing to speak out on their behalf.
- Create an advocacy team of women who will disperse information, speak up for and help Dalit and other Indian women and girls. Programs for Indian women are making a difference, but they require resources: Indian Christian leaders with boldness and initiative, financial investment and the sacrificial work of strong advocates.
- Our culture portrays Hinduism (along with Buddhism) as a benign, pacifist religion. Become acquainted with the truth of this religion rooted in demonology, and be ready to challenge the prevalent misperceptions.
- Contact your senators and representatives and express concern for the well-being of Christians in Pakistan. Ask elected officials to make an inquiry into the status of those being held on charges stemming from the Blasphemy law.
